## 1 Cor. 3:1-11

- 1. Read the text.
- 2. Try to put yourself in the shoes of a 1<sup>st</sup> C. Corinthian Christian whose just heard this letter read out loud in church for the first time. How would Paul's words affect you? How would Paul's exhortation confront your worldview?
- 3. What's Paul's big idea in this passage? Express that idea using a full sentence, not just a word or phrase.
- 4. How does Paul describe leadership in this text? What can we glean from Paul's words for our present situation?
- 5. Discuss the metaphor of a local church being a field (vs. 9). How does this metaphor help us understand and appreciate the different cycles or seasons of a church? What kind of season have we come through? What kind of season can you envision PCC entering into?
- 6. What would it take for PCC's season of transition to result in spiritual transformation? What could derail us from transformation?
- 7. How does Psalm 23 speak into our current reality?
