The Purpose of This Prayer Guide

THIS BOOKLET WAS CREATED TO SERVE AS A GUIDE FOR YOU TO PRAY FOR YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD AND YOUR CITY.

THE LORD INVITES US INTO HIS REDEEMING WORK AND ONE OF THE WAYS HE INVITES US TO PARTICIPATE IS THROUGH PRAYER. WE SEE THROUGHOUT SCRIPTURE AND THROUGHOUT CHURCH HISTORY THAT PRAYER IS ESSENTIAL TO THE CHRISTIAN LIFE AND TO THE GREAT COMMISSION.

WE DESIRE TO BE A PRAYING PEOPLE, A PEOPLE WHO WILL BE INTENTIONAL TO COME BEFORE THE LORD IN PRAYER ABOUT THE CITIES WE LIVE IN, THE PLACES WE PASS BY, AND THE PEOPLE WE CALL NEIGHBOURS.

WITHIN, YOU'LL FIND PRAYER POINTS FOR THE CITY INCLUDING SPECIFIC LOCATIONS, A GUIDE ON HOW TO PRAYER WALK AND SOME EXAMPLE ROUTES, EXAMPLES OF SCRIPTURE TO PRAY OVER YOUR CITY, AND RESOURCES RELATED TO PRAYER AND EVANGELISM.

OUR PRAYER IS THAT THROUGH USING THIS GUIDE, YOU WILL DEVELOP A REGULAR PRACTICE OF PRAYING FOR YOUR CITY AND THAT THE LORD WILL CONTINUALLY GROW YOUR HEART AND REVEAL TO YOU HIS HEART FOR THE PLACE YOU CALL HOME AND THE PEOPLE WHO LIVE IN IT.

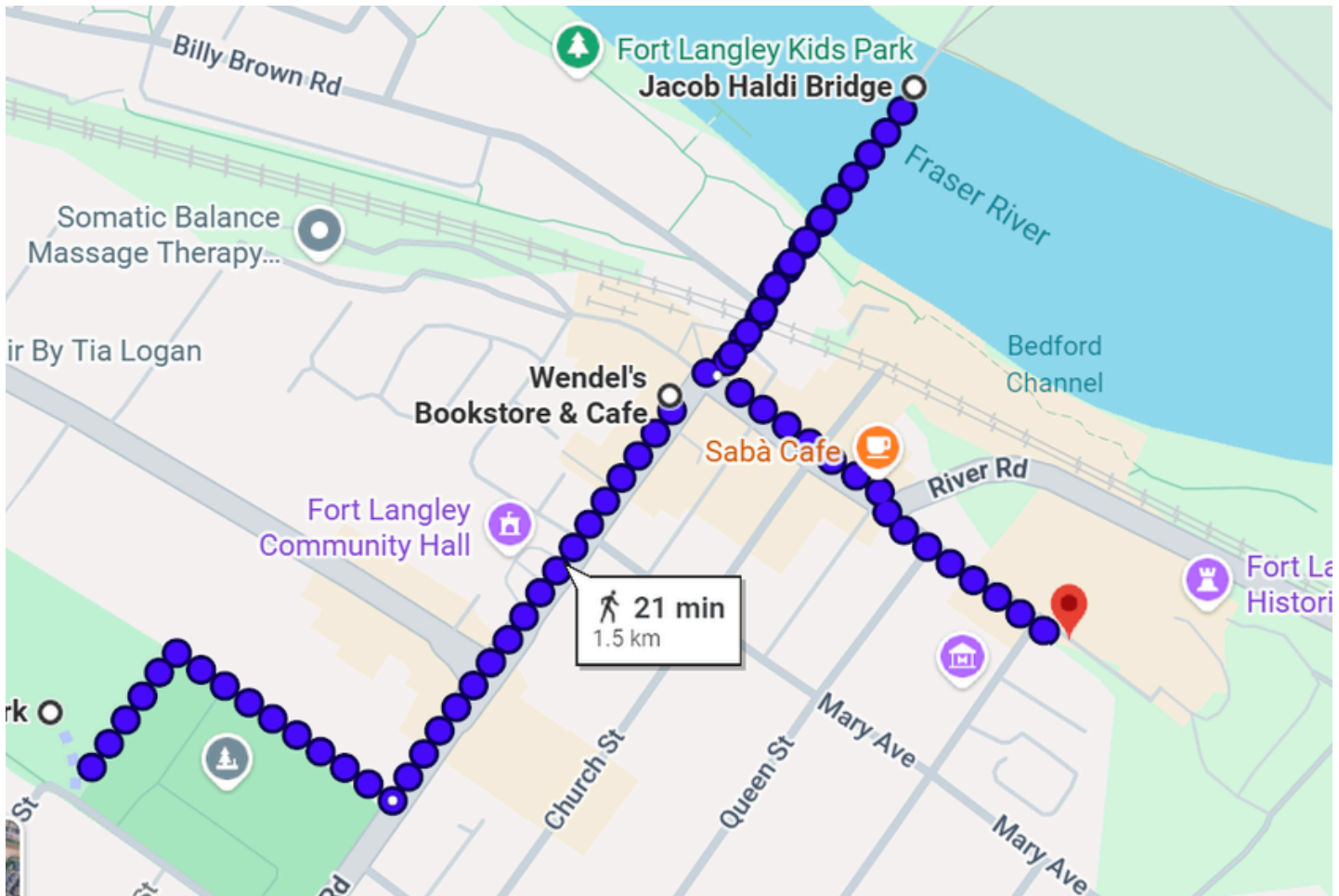
Prayer Walk Guide

PRAYER WALKS ALLOW US TO SEE THE PLACES AND THE PEOPLE WE ARE PRAYING FOR, CULTIVATE FOCUS, AND ARE A GREAT WAY TO BE INTENTIONAL IN PRAYING OVER OUR CITY. YOU ALSO NEVER KNOW WHO THE LORD MIGHT BRING ALONG YOUR PATH OR WHAT HE WILL HIGHLIGHT OR SPEAK TO YOU ABOUT AS YOU WALK THROUGH YOUR COMMUNITY.

TIPS FOR PRAYER WALKS

- Walk slowly & intentionally.
- Pray over the places you pass and the people you pass.
- As you walk, ask the Lord who or what He is highlighting you to pray for or with.
- Walk in silence or listen to worship music.
- Pray scripture over your city.
- Write down specific things the Lord speaks to you or about your city.

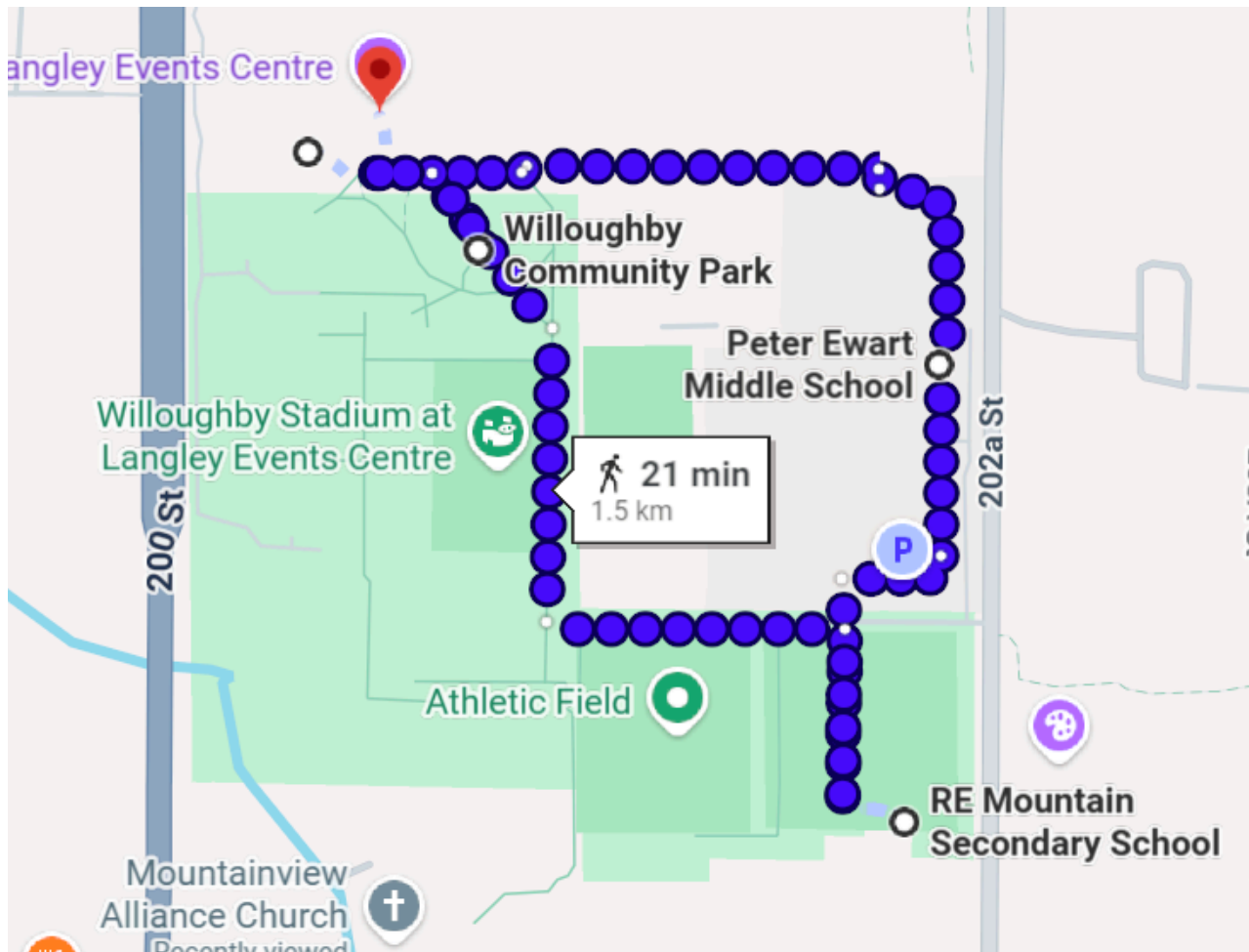

Prayer Point #1: Thanksgiving

SPEND SOME
TIME IN PRAISE &
THANKSGIVING.

- Thank God for who He is. Thank Him that He is a God who hears our prayers. (1 John 5:14)
 - Thank Him for how He is at work in your city and for His sovereignty.
 - Thank Him for placing you in this city for this specific time. Thank Him for the Great Commission and for inviting you into His redeeming work.
- Take some time to thank the Lord for your city. What people and places within your city are you grateful for? What communities, people or places bring you joy?



Prayer Point #2: Neighbours

TAKE SOME TIME TO PRAY FOR YOUR GEOGRAPHICAL NEIGHBOURS AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS. ASK THE LORD IF THERE ARE SPECIFIC PEOPLE HE WANTS YOU TO COMMIT TO PRAYING FOR.

- Pray for them to come to know Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.
- Pray for their health, safety, and for provision in their lives.
- Pray for reconciliation, healing, and unity within their lives and families.
- Pray for opportunities to be a light and share about Jesus with them.

Prayer Point #3:

Revival In Your City

FOR THE NEXT PRAYER PROMPT, SPEND SOME TIME PRAYING FOR GOD TO POUR OUT SALVATION IN YOUR CITY, TO BRING PEOPLE INTO RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM, AND TO EQUIP AND SUSTAIN OUTREACH MINISTRIES.



- Pray for individuals in your city to put their faith in God and that their lives would be transformed by Him.
- Pray for God's Kingdom to come and His will to be done in your city.
- Pray for people of other religions to come to know Jesus as the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Is there a certain group that God is placing on your heart? Pray for them.
- Pray for believers and churches to develop intentional, flourishing, and creative ways to reach and serve the community and for the Lord to sustain and work through existing outreach ministries.

Prayer Point #3:

Revival In Your City

- Pray for people to be sent to those who don't know Jesus to share with them. Pray for softened hearts and for Spirit-led conversations. Pray for believers to have the courage to go into the hard and dark places in your city.

- Pray for the families and friends of people in your church who haven't placed their faith in Jesus to come to know Him.
- Who in your community, workplace, or daily life doesn't know Jesus? Pray for them by name. Ask the Lord how He wants to use you.
- Thank God that you are sent. (Matthew 28:18-20) Ask Him to bring divine conversations and interactions into your life and for the boldness and the love to steward those interactions as well as the relationships you have in your daily life.

Prayer Point #4:

People & Workplaces of Your City



- Pray for different occupations (first responders, teachers, professionals, business owners, & educational staff, healthcare workers, etc.).
- Pray for the safety and the unity of workplaces and workers.
- Pray for believers to be in every sector of work and to be living on mission in their day-to-day lives.
- Pray for your mayor, your MLA, your MP, and all those who serve within government. Pray for wisdom and for guidance as they make decisions and direct the future of the city.
- Pray for individuals looking for work.

Prayer Point #7: Local Churches & Believers

SPEND TIME PRAYING OVER LOCAL CHURCHES, BELIEVERS, AND CHURCH LEADERS. MAY THE CHURCH BE UNITED IN THE GREAT COMMISSION AS WE DISCIPLE PEOPLE AND REACH THE UNCHURCHED.



- Pray for intentional discipleship, spiritual growth and sanctification.
- Pray for believers across your city to have their eyes fixed upon Jesus, to be unashamed of the gospel, and to be Kingdom-minded in their everyday lives.
- Pray for the flourishing of churches and that they would be Christ-like and missionally focused in all they do.

New Skytrain



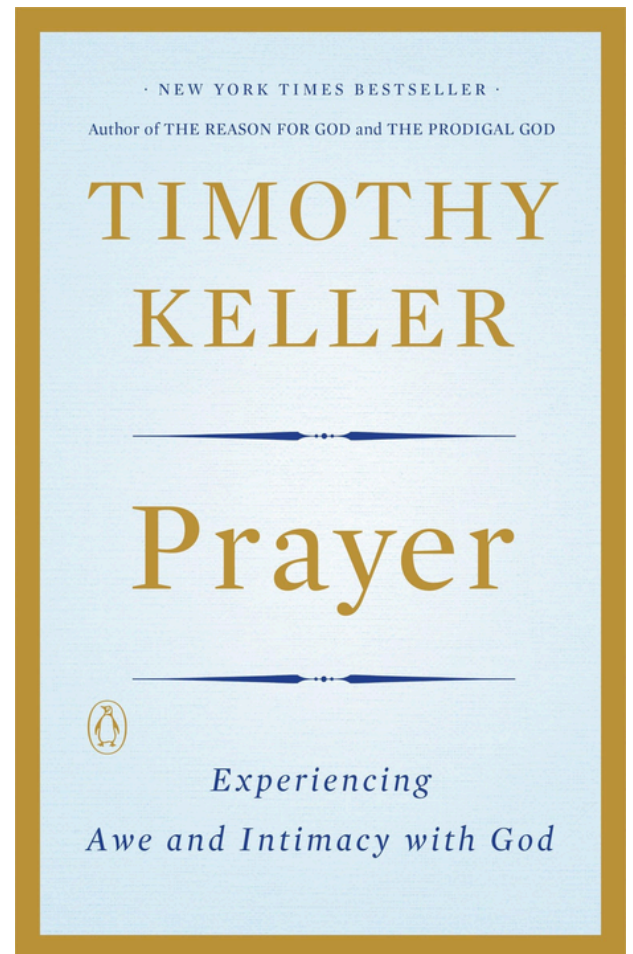
- Pray for sufficient staff to be provided and for the workers building the Skytrain.

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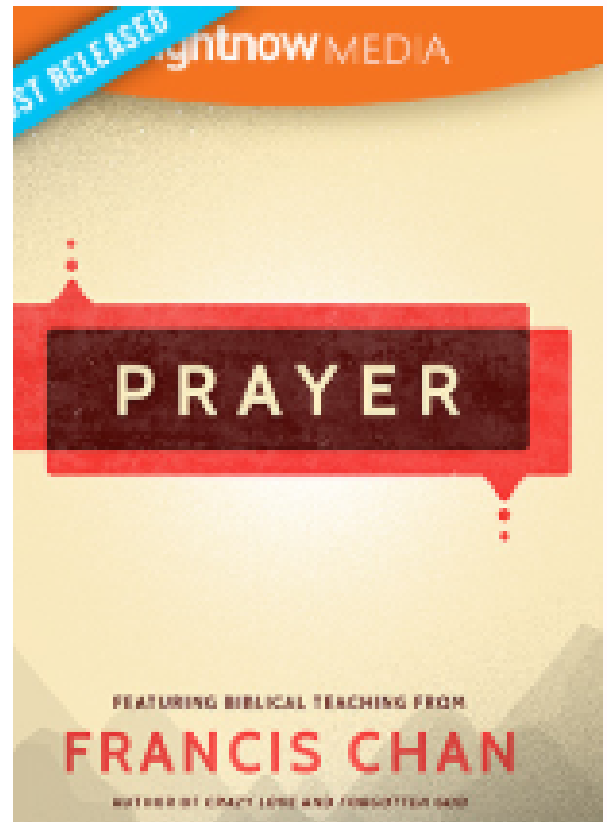
PRAYER (YOUTH SERIES)
